The CRHA YOUTH PROGRAM recognizes annual National Youth Members of the CRHA through a series of HIGH POINT Awards in VAROIUS AGES GROUPS and CATEGORIES. These awards can be earned at 4-H, OPEN, CRHA and other ORGANIZED EVENTS. (Event must be sanctioned by an organization – NOT "STABLING SCHOOLING SHOWS"). Youth can be enrolled in the program providing they are CRHA YOUTH MEMBERS. A CRHA YOUTH may participate from the time they can sit a horse and be led (lead-line) through their 18th birth year (age 18 as of Jan 1st).

Rules are simple. 1. "The Youth MUST COMPETE ON A REGISTERED RANGERBRED A/O RANGERBREDS (Youth can show more than one horse). 2. \$10.00 Enrollment Fee must be paid prior to competing in any show that he/she is awards points. Send to **Chairperson above.** 3. Following enrollment, you may download from CRHA Facebook page or available at www.coloradoranger.com) that MUST BE **COMPLETED IN FULL AND RETURNED TO THE YOUTH CHAIRPERSON** WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE SHOW with a **copy of the show bill included.** You may scan and send by email to the above address of chairperson.

Points are tallied according to how many exhibitors are entered in the class. One point for everyone that the Youth placed in front of will be issued. If the member placed 5th in a class of 25 entries, 20 points will be issued. If he/she placed 1st in the same class, 25 points will be issued (24 for placing in front of 24 participants & 1 point extra for winning). The YA PROGRAM DOES GIVE 1 POINT CREDIT FOR BEING THE ONLY PARTICIPANT. BUT, NO POINTS ARE ISSUED IF YOUTH IS BELOW 1ST PLACE & THERE ARE NO PARTICIPANTS BEHIND YOUTH. (5th out of 5 receives no points). Placings under the Danish system not accepted.

There are two age divisions: JUNIOR and SENIOR. JUNIORS are from lead-line age through 13 yrs of age (Jan 1st current year); SENIORS are 14 yrs through 18 yrs of age (Jan 1st current year). You cannot show lead-line & walk-trot the same season and collect points for both. If youth begins the year lead-line and ends walk-trot, one group of points must be relinquished. If youth begins year, in walk-trot and later canters, one group of points must be relinquished. All points can be counted toward overall but, not for individual categories. For the sake of this program Showmanship and Halter will be classified in the same division.
